CONTEST THEME

REQUIREMENTS

- Open to all students grades K-12. Only one art piece per student may be submitted
- Must include at least one aspect of the 1962 Seattle World's Fair
- Must incorporate Asian Pacific Islander heritage and culture in America
- Must be original and made specifically for this contest
- Artwork must be mounted on middle-weight standard art board with 2" border (preferred size is 8" x 15")
- Attach a card in the lower left hand corner with the title of the piece, medium (materials used in your artwork: e.g., watercolor, pencil, oil paint), and your name, grade, and school
- Complete art contest entry form and submit it with your artwork

CONTEST DEADLINE

Thursday, April 26, 2012, 5:00pm. Artwork entries can be dropped off at the front desk at the Wing Luke Museum, 719 South King Street, Seattle, WA 98104, Tuesday-Sunday 10:00am-5:00pm, 10:00am-8:00pm on the First Thursday and Third Saturday of every month.

JUDGING AND AWARDS

A panel of artists and art professionals will judge artwork entries. All entries will be on display at the API Heritage Month Celebration on Sunday, May 6, 2012 from 12:00pm to 5:00pm at the Seattle Center. Winners will also have their artwork displayed at the Wing Luke Museum and other select locations during the month of May. At Wing Luke Museum, the winners will also have unlimited free access to their pieces during the month of May.

ARTWORK PICKUP

Winners will be contacted the week of April 30, 2012. All other artwork entries must be picked up at Wing Luke Museum from May 7 through June 29, 2012. Any unclaimed artwork will become the property of the API Heritage Month Celebration Committee.
